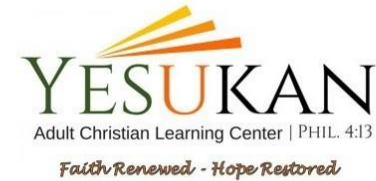

Student Services



Free classes are provided to strengthen adults educationally. The core classes are English, both speaking and grammar; Reading, Writing and Computer Basics. Evening classes are offered on Mondays, Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays. Morning classes are available on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

Business Benefits



Options: 1. Allow current employees to improve in their written and oral English communication skills. 2. Require new hires with a strong potential, to attend classes during their probationary period. Six weeks to three months would be recommended. 3. Utilize Yesukan students as a staff source.
